1997	New Headmistress , Pauline McGowan	Major Simon Crisp died aged 59. He was succeeded by Mr Edward Crisp
1997	William (Bill) George Jenner, rector	
1999	Hazel Harvey killed in a road accident in Stockton, the Rev. Reg Harvey died from his injuries shortly afterwards. 'The Bird in Hand' becomes a restaurant renamed 'The Olive tree'
