This added weight to the campaign being mounted by the parish council for land to be made available, to relieve the traffic problems near the school and the playing field.
Recent history	18th November 2019 - Loss of water supply
A chronology of Ellingham & Kirby Cane	Parishioners in Ellingham & Kirby Cane awoke to find no water from their taps. A burst water main affected hundreds of properties in the area but service was resumed later in the morning. The old Yarmouth Road, from the junction of Church Road towards Geldestone, was closed for several days after whilst repairs were made good.

History of Memorial Hall	Local bands Strapt 4 Cash and Best of Both played great music on the playing field. More than £600 raised for local causes.
